N: Native range includes east of the Mississippi River and natives.

N¹: Choose single white flowering malus to most closely replicate native species. Natives attract significantly more pollinators.

N²: Native viburnum include: V. acerfolium (Mapleleaf), V.dentatum (Arrowwood), V. lantana (Wayfaringtree), V. lentago (Nannyberry), V. prunifolium (Blackhaw)

N³: Only Arborescens and Quercifolia are native.

N⁴: Only Agastache s. is native this includes Blue Fortune and Blue Boa.

N⁵: Only Verbena h. (Swamp Verbena) is native.
